## Notes

### 1. Doctoral Degree Programs

Plan 1 is a plan of study that emphasizes on conducting a research study. The students are required to do a dissertation that can create a new body of knowledge. They may be required to take more courses of study or do some other academic activities with no credit counts.

Plan 2 is a plan of study that emphasizes on conducting a research study. The students are required to do a dissertation that can cause academic and professional advancement and take more courses of study as prescribed by the University.

### 2. Master's Degree Programs

Plan A: Type A (1) Plan 1 is a plan of study that requires the students to do only a thesis. They may be required to take more courses of study or do some other academic activities with no credit counts.

Plan A: Type A (2) is a plan of study that aims to educate the students to be researchers ready in terms of contents, methodology, and skills for conducting a research study in their specialized fields. They are required to take at least 36 credits.

Plan B is a plan of study that emphasizes independent study. Its primary purpose is to educate the students to be advanced and well-rounded academics in multidisciplinary fields and can make their knowledge applicable. They are required to take at least 36 credits.

## 2. General Qualifications of the Applicants

An applicant for admission must be qualified as follows:

### 2.1 For a doctoral degree

2.1.1 Holding a bachelor's degree or a master's degree

2.1.2 Having other qualifications as prescribed by the field of study (as detailed in the announcement of each field of study).

2.1.3 Having a test score from one of the following tests

TOEFL ITP	not less than 480 points
TOEFL iBT	no less than 50 points
IELTS	no less than 5.0 points
MJU-TEP	no less than 50 points
CU-TEP	no less than 50 points
CMU-eTEGS	not lower than 45.

**Note** The applicants are required to submit their application form with all the documents mentioned in 2.1.1-2.1.3 If they cannot submit them on the application date, they may submit them on the day of the self-report to be university students.

2.2.1 Holding a bachelor's degree

2.2.2 Having other qualifications as prescribed by the field of study (as detailed in the announcement of each field of study).

### **3. Qualifications for Applicants in Certain Fields of Study**

Besides the qualifications mentioned in 2, the applicants must have specific qualifications and conditions as specified by certain fields of study as prescribed in detail in the attachment.

### **4. Applying via online and Paying Application fee for 500 baht**

Any applicants may apply for admission online at [www.grad.mju.ac.th/apply](http://www.grad.mju.ac.th/apply) and pay an application fee for 500 baht (only five hundred baht) at any Bangkok Bank branches all over the country. The service fee is not included.

### **5. Sending an Application Form**

The applicants may send their application forms with all required documents to the Graduate Studies Department in 3 ways:

- 1) Upload the application via the Internet
- 2) Submit the application form by themselves or ask someone to do it for them at the Graduate Studies Department
- 3) Send your application via the post office

**Method 1:** Upload their signed application form with all required documents via the Internet

The applicants may upload their signed application forms with all required documents via the Internet at [www.grad.mju.ac.th/apply](http://www.grad.mju.ac.th/apply). They can access this website 24 hours during the admission period except for the last day when they can do so only before 4 pm.

**Method 2:** Submit the application form by themselves or ask someone to do it for them

The applicants may submit their application forms or ask someone to do so for them at the Graduate Studies Department on the First Floor of Thepsart Stit Building at Maejo University. They can fill out the application forms via the Internet and print them or download the application forms and fill the forms following the instructions on the website. Check all the required documents, sign their names on the application forms, and

pay 500 baht (ONLY five hundred baht) for application fees at any branches of Bangkok Bank all over the country. The service fee is not included.

Those who choose to use Methods 1 or 2 can proceed with their applications in the following periods:

**During Semester 1/2020**

The first round is on November 25, 2020, until January 31, 2020

The second round is on February 1, 2020, until March 31, 2020

The third round is on April 1, 2020, until May 13, 2020.

**During Semester 2/2020**

The period opening for applications is on June 1, 2020, until September 23, 2020.

The official time is between 8:30 am. and 4:00 pm. (except on public holidays).

If the applicants ask someone to submit the application forms for them, they have to fill up the forms and all required documents entirely by themselves.

**Method 3:** Send their application via the post office

The applicants can complete their application forms via the Internet and then print them or download the forms and complete them following the instructions on the website. Sign their names on the application forms, check all the required documents, and pay 500 baht (ONLY five hundred baht) for application fees at any branches of Bangkok Bank all over the country. The service fee is not included. Attach a picture on the application form and send all required documents by post to the Graduate Studies Department:

**During Semester 1/2020**

The first round is on November 25, 2020, until January 24, 2020.

The second round is on February 1, 2020, until March 24, 2020.

The third round is on April 1, 2020, until May 6, 2020.

**During Semester 2/2020**

The period opening for applications is on June 1, 2020, until September 16, 2020.

The applicants must send their application forms with a photo attached and all required documents to the Graduate Studies Department within the mentioned periods. **The stamped date on the envelope is used as a piece of evidence.**

  - 2) The applicants must certify a true copy of all required documents. The applications are considered complete when the application forms, all required documents, and application fees have been received by the Graduate Studies Department.

  - 6.3 A 1-inch photo shot straight-face with no hat or black sunglasses and taken within 6 months (attach to the application form or uploaded when using Method 1)
  - 6.4 A copy of rename or re-surname certificates or a copy of the marriage certificate (in case of the name and/or surname are different from those in other documents).
  - 6.5 Educational evidence
- For a doctoral degree**
1. A copy of transcripts at a master's degree level (excepted for those who will be studying in Plans 1.2 or 2.2).
  2. A copy of transcripts at a bachelor's degree level
- For a master's degree**
1. A copy of transcripts at a bachelor's degree level
  1. A copy of transcripts at a Higher Vocational Certificate or Certificate of Technical Vocation or a diploma level (excepted for those who graduated from a 4-year bachelor's degree program)
- 6.6 A copy of the results of the English test as mentioned in 2.1 (for doctoral applicants)
  - 6.7 A student certificate for studying in the final semester of the program. (If the applicant is studying in the final semester of an undergraduate program.)
  - 6.8 A copy of the application fee payment form (copy to an A-4 paper) for 500 baht via Bangkok Bank (Public Company Limited)
  - 6.9 Other documents (in accordance with the attached details of each field of study)

6.10 For those applicants who are government officials or government enterprise officials and want to study at the graduate level in a regular program, they must have a permission letter from their supervisors from their workplace to show to the Graduate Studies Department.

All documents must be certified by the applicants as a true copy.

### **Notes**

- 1) The university will not return the application fees and application forms to the applicants in all circumstances, except the application for admission is officially canceled.
- 2) If any accompanying documents are later found fake, the university will withdraw the student status of the holders immediately.

### **7. Applicant Scrutinization**

7.1 If any applicants submit an incomplete or incorrect application form and the required documents, the Graduate Studies Department will not announce their names as eligible test-takers.

7.2 On the examination day, all eligible test-takers (according to the list of eligible test-takers) must take with them their application ID card and Thai Citizen ID card or any official card to the examination room; otherwise, they will not be allowed to enter the examination room.
